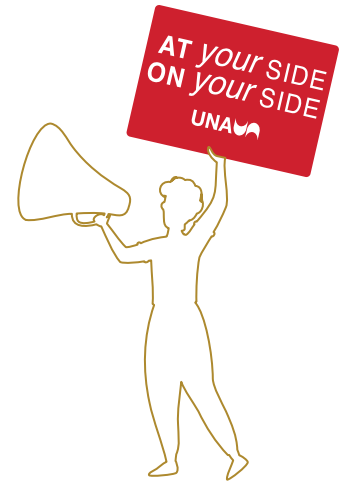


Tip sheet for UNA Members on a PICKET LINE



As a UNA member, you are on the picket line to inform the public that a strike or picket is in progress and the reasons for it. Here are a few tips to help you stay safe and effectively deliver your/UNA's message:

- Carry your UNA membership card/info at all times. Card is available on UNA's app.
- Be sure to report when you arrive and leave the picket line.
- Take your instructions from your Picket Line Captain.
- Follow direction from law enforcement.
- Don't allow yourself to be provoked by anti-union individuals or groups.
- Report any provocation to your Picket Line Captain.
- Report any unusual incidents or problems to your Picket Line Captain.
- Call 911 if any serious incidence, threats, or injury occur. Then report to the Picket Line Captain ASAP.
- Stay moving. Don't bunch together.
- Always be respectful with our engagement with others.
- Dress appropriately for the weather. (eg. Hats, sunscreen, umbrellas, appropriate foot wear.)
- Don't obstruct emergency vehicles.
- Avoid blocking public sidewalks.
- Be clean and respectful of your surroundings.
- Bring your family but if you have small children keep a watchful eye on them.
- Refer the media to the Picket Line Captain.
- Bring a sense of humour and have fun, laugh, tell stories, sing, dance.
