Updates on the ongoing work to revise the PRC Best Practice Guidelines and implement the new Safe Staffing Letter of Understanding (LoU).

PRC Forum Meetings

- As a trial through the end of the year, the AHS and Covenant Health PRC
 Forums have been combined. We've also agreed to develop a
 single PRC & Safe Staffing Best Practices document that will apply to
 all Employers under the Provincial Collective Agreement.
- A sub-committee of the PRC Forum has been tasked with updating the Best Practices document, and we're nearing completion.

Safe Staffing Letter of Understanding (LoU)

- While this work has taken longer than expected, we've reached an agreement with the Employers on the initial list of clinical and operational data that will inform discussions about baseline staffing.
 - The Employers have developed a PRC Safe Staffing Dashboard, which will allow managers to access some of this data in a more streamlined and accessible way.
- We continue to collaborate with the Employers to finalize the best practice guidance, which will clarify how this new process aligns with the existing PRC process and outline roles and responsibilities at each step.
- The plan is to trial this new process in one AHS and one Covenant Health unit/program/area before a broader rollout.
