

## Medication Claim Denial Appeal Form

Employees covered by the collective agreement between United Nurses of Alberta(UNA) and Alberta Health Services(AHS) who have had claims for prescription medication denied may submit them for review and possible reimbursement.

Employees are required to appeal within 30 days of receiving their claim denial. Claims must meet the criteria as outlined in Article 21.01 (a)(ii) and supporting documentation must be supplied.

The completed form and documentation are to be emailed to [employeebenefitsandretirementprograms@ahs.ca](mailto:employeebenefitsandretirementprograms@ahs.ca). Appeals will be reviewed within 14 days of receipt of the appeal form.
