<u>Alberta's Nurses Secure New Agreement that Provides</u> <u>Hope, Respect and Recognition!</u>

UNA members have spoken loud and clear! With an overwhelming 95.74%

approval, Alberta's nurses have officially ratified a new four-year agreement.

Throughout negotiations, UNA members have been asking for the government to commit to "Three Rs" - Respect, Retain, and Recruit. All are reflected in this new agreement.

The four-year agreement will make Alberta nurses again the highest paid in any Canadian province and includes key provisions including stronger job security provisions during health care restructuring and an explicit commitment to provide "safe staffing for all patients, residents, and clients" through a new process that facilitates an evidence-based review of staffing levels.

After months of tough negotiations, this deal represents a major victory for Alberta's nurses and health care system. It's also an indication of how <u>It Could Be</u> <u>Better Here.</u>
