Negotiation Update: Progress and Priorities

On February 6, UNA exchanged proposals with key employers including AHS, Covenant, Lamont, and Bethany Camrose. While the employers' initial package lacked monetary components, they committed to presenting monetary proposals this week.

Their priorities include stabilizing workplaces, expediting recruitment, addressing

staffing gaps, managing internal movement, and increasing full-time employment. Additionally, concerns regarding relief shifts and payroll processes were discussed.

The next bargaining dates are set for February 14 and 15.
