To fix the problem, the UNA has proposed a research backed framework that is based on three fundamental principles – Respect, Retention and Recruitment.


The 3Rs campaign aims to bring awareness to the public about the critical nursing challenges. It's also a call for the government to implement these immediate, tangible solutions.
